and Seminary (ACCS)

To whom it may concern,

I am writing on behalf of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS) to clarify the accreditation status of the Teach Out Plan for American Christian College and Seminary. In short, students who had completed 75% of their degree program prior to June of 2004 were allowed to earn an accredited degree, provided that the course work was completed by the end of May 2005. No degrees were awarded for students who had requirements lacking after May 31, 2005.

The Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS) Executive Director, Dr. Russell Fitzgerald, appointed me to direct and oversee the Teach Out Plan for American Christian College and Seminary. ACCS provided the course work to complete the degrees for qualified students.
